

#### **CONTROLLED ACCESS ZONES**

## Setting Up Control Lines for Controlled Access Zones

When control lines are used	Not less than 6 feet, no more than 25 feet from unprotected or leading edge (except when erecting precast concrete members)	
When erecting precast concrete members	Not less than 6 feet, no more than 60 feet or half the length of the member being erected (whichever is less) from the leading edge	

### **Control Lines**

The Control Line shall

- 1. Extend along the entire length of the unprotected or leading edge and shall be approximately parallel to the unprotected or leading edge.
- 2. Be connected on each side to a standard railing or wall, or securely anchored on each end.

Control lines shall consist of ropes, wires, tapes, or equivalent materials, and supporting stanchions as follows:

- A. Each line shall be flagged or otherwise clearly marked at not more than 6-foot intervals with high-visibility material.
- B. Each line shall be rigged and supported in such a way that its lowest point (including sag) is not less than 39
  - inches from the working level/working area and its highest point is not more than 45 inches.
- C. Each line shall have a minimum breaking strength of 200 pounds.

#### **Safety Monitoring System**

The employer shall designate a competent person to monitor the safety of other employees and the employer shall ensure that the safety monitor complies with the following requirements:

- A. The safety monitor shall be competent to recognize fall hazards;
- B. The safety monitor shall warn the employee when it appears that the employee is unaware of a fall hazard or is acting in an unsafe manner;
- C. The safety monitor shall be within visual sighting distance of the employee and shall always be in communication with the employee being monitored; and,
- D. The safety monitor shall not have other responsibilities which could take the monitor's attention from the monitoring function.

No employee, other than an employee covered by a fall protection plan, shall be allowed in an area where an employee is being protected by a safety monitoring system. Each employee working in a controlled access zone shall be directed to comply promptly with fall hazard warnings from safety monitors.
